The 2025 program aims to engage in a comprehensive exploration of how Al technologies intersect with pressing issues of power dynamics, social justice, and equity, especially through the lens of Global South countries, which face challenges and opportunities of their own in this rapidly evolving field. As Al systems increasingly influence decision-making processes across various sectors, including healthcare, education, and criminal justice, it is paramount that future legal professionals comprehend the multifaceted consequences of these technologies.

You decide whether you want to travel to Pretoria in April 2025 or to Santiago de Chile in May 2025. You'll visit the respective partner university for ten days. The return visit of South African and Chilean students to Hamburg will take place in September 2025, bringing all participants together. Between April/May and September you will work online along with your international tandem partner on a position paper.
