From 2 to 13 December, States will give their input on the **Advisory Opinion (AO) on the obligations of States in respect of climate change** from the International Court of Justice (ICJ).

This AO is highly-anticipated. It has the potential to **clarify rights and duties** with respect to climate change and to **contribute to climate justice**.

World's Youth for Climate Justice (WYCJ) is among the organizations which called for an AO, and now invites individuals and organizations around the world under the slogan **#TheWorldisWatching** to stream the hearings!

On the part of the Faculty of Law of the University of Hamburg, the program **Climate Law in International Context (CLIC)** and the **Jessup Moot Court Alumni Association Hamburg e.V.** invite you to join a watch party on **11 December, 9:30 A.M. to 11:30 A.M.**!

A **speaker from WYCJ** will first provide an input on the ICJ AO: What is an AO? How did the case come about? What is so special about this climate case? We will then **watch the submissions** of two states via the ICJ livestream. Afterwards, we will have a **round table discussion** to share initial thoughts, to place the submissions in the broader context and to answer questions from the audience!
